Whereas, there has been deposited in the **General Land Office** of the United States, a **CERTIFICATE** of the Register of the Land Office at *Traverse City Michigan*, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of *Patrick Coleman*

has been established and duly consummated in

conformity to law for the South East Quarter of the North West Quarter and the East Half of the South West Quarter and the South West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Fourteen in Township Thirty North of Range Nine West, in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at *Traverse City Michigan* containing One Hundred and Sixty Acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **General Land Office** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the **UNITED STATES** unto the said *Patrick Coleman*.

the tract of Land above described: **To Have and to Hold** the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Patrick Coleman* and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, *J. Ulysses S. Grant*, PRESIDENT OF THE **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the **Seal of the General Land Office** to be hereunto affixed.
